The Launch

Building the Dream

We have the opportunity to receive \$7,500 from the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (IHCDA), but only if we raise \$7,500 first!

The campaign begins on Saturday, October 28th and it will go through Friday, December 8th. The funds that are raised from our Cicero neighbors, and the matching funds from IHCDA, along with additional funding that the Cicero Parks Department has already raised, will allow us to do the following:

- 1. Build and install the canoe/kayak launch
- 2. Build a **walkway** to the launch that connects to the park trail
- 3. Install lighting and signage
- 4. Expand the parking lot to include additional **parking**
