RE: Proposal

Greetings Paul:

Aaron and I discussed the Town's desire to create an overlay district for the prominent SR 19 Corridor and Downtown area. This is a good planning tool for special character areas of the Town where additional development and design requirements can be superimposed on top of the basic minimum requirements of the underlying base zoning districts. An overlay district would:

- Provide for a district that will permit the expansion, redevelopment and infill of the mixed-use development currently found in small incorporated and unincorporated areas throughout the County;
- Preserve and promote traditional town building compatible with the visual character and architectural scale of existing development with grid pattern of streets, alleys and blocks;
- Promote development that is designed to accommodate pedestrian and vehicular traffic;
- 2. Require visual buffers where commercial uses occur adjacent to existing residential; and
- Preserve and promote the location of dwellings, shops and workplaces in close proximity to each other, and permitting residential uses on upper floors of buildings in commercial areas.

Aaron asked me to submit an estimate to accomplish this task. I have prepared an outline of potential costs below which could be affected by several factors we would consider:

- The goals and objectives of the Comprehensive Plan
- The goals, objectives and specific recommendations of the Downtown Revitalization Plan
- The amount of public engagement to get community support and buy-in

RATIO is familiar with the Town's Ordinances, having just reformatted all and updated portions of the Zoning Ordinance in 2015. An overlay district could be added as an additional chapter in the existing ordinance with cross-references to it added throughout the ordinance. Our proposed tasks and estimate of probable cost below also includes assisting town staff through the adoption process.

TASKS

1. Staff, stakeholder and community engagement (three trips)

- 4. Adoption Hearings (Plan Commission and Town Council) (two trips)
- 5. Final Production
