2. Approval of Minutes

Mr. Zell made motion to approve Minutes from PC Meeting: January 9, 2019 as presented. Mr. Martin second. All present in favor.

3. <u>Public Comment</u> President Strong stated time for comments from public on items not on the agenda.

Bill Holiday as president of HOA for Morse Landing West stated wanted to get concerns out of the way. Concerning Morse Landing West, silk fences been addressed several times, trash is the same. Policing of these items are a concern. Parking in front of mailboxes. Realize that there are only three lots left but bringing up issues because they continue and concerns about M/I project as well. Mr. Holiday continued with concern for follow through on water line, tearing up of properties. Other concerns are drainage and swells, construction standards require swells. Worried about M/I, can not fix West but want to give the history lesson to assist with drainage for M/I. Mr. Holiday continued with lights and sidewalks and issues with West and agreements with Town. Silverthorne has problem with Lincoln model, and as president of HOA has sent individuals to CJ. Feels there are legal concerns.

Mr. Holiday went on to share past concerns about issues, and holding permits, certificates etc. may be necessary. Silverthorne needs to clean up their act, it is not their subdivision. Trespass on entry, toilets on empty lots not the construction lot. Hoping they are looking at M/I, watching each aspect.

President Strong responded that they have learned with each subdivision that has come along.

Mr. Zell questioned the Lincoln model. Mr. Taylor explained that the master bathroom is over the garage, causing cold bathrooms and busted pipes in some. Mr. Taylor explained where at in the process. There is no control on the part of Mr. Taylor other than not allowing Lincoln model to be built in the future. The buildings did meet code, however that doesn't mean it is the best design.

President Strong asked if other public with comments. Seeing none, moved forward.
