The Cicero Sports Complex Closed to the Public through May 1st

Cicero, IN.-The Town of Cicero has announced the Cicero Sports Complex (the baseball and softball fields) are closed to the public effective immediately through May 1st. The date is subject to change with the COVID-19 emergency. The Town of Cicero activated new health and safety measures last week to keep town employees and the community safe by restricting public access to all town owned buildings and suspending all Town of Cicero Parks Department Programs.

“Public health and safety are our top priorities and measures must be taken to help curb the spread of COVID-19 in our community and beyond,” said Dan Strong, Cicero Town Council President.

In addition to the closure of the Cicero Sports Complex, the following list includes additional health and safety measures that the Town has created in accordance with recommendations made by the Governor’s office and the Center for Disease Control (CDC). The Town will continue to evaluate the situation and restrictions.

- The Town of Cicero is restricting public access to all town buildings. Each department will remain open and will be able to address questions and concerns.
- Payments to the Town of Cicero for utilities or transaction made through the Clerk-Treasurer’s office should be made using the drop payment box located at the Town Municipal Building, located at 331 East Jackson Street. Questions can be sent to the Clerk-Treasurer’s office at 317-984-4900.
- No public meetings will be scheduled before April 6th. Please feel free to contact any council person with any questions regarding town business or concerns.
- All town parks and shelters will remain open to be used by the public at your discretion.
- The building permit application can be submitted online at: www.cicero.in.gov or you can email C.J. Taylor, Cicero/Jackson Township Plan Commission Director at ctaylor@townofcicero.in.gov or you may call the Plan Commission office directly.
- All Town provided utilities such as trash, recycling, water, and sewer, as well as maintenance of streets and sidewalks, will continue to be provided.

- The Town of Cicero Police Department and the Town of Cicero Fire Department will continue to operate as usual and will continue to provide for the safety needs of our community.
- If you or your organization scheduled a meeting or an event at any town buildings, those will need to be cancelled and rescheduled when the Town Council approves opening these back up to the public.
