NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED INCREASE IN WATER RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE TOWN OF CICERO, INDIANA

Property owners and other interested parties in the Town of Cicero, Indiana, are hereby notified that the Rate <u>Ordinance Number 11-17-2020-3</u>, increasing the rates and charges for services to be rendered by the water works, was introduced at a meeting of the Council held on November 17, 2020.

A public hearing of the Council will be held at 7:00 PM, local time, on January 5, 2021 at Red Bridge Community Building, 697 W Jackson St., Cicero, Indiana on the matter of the rates and charges. The Council will convene and may consider the adoption of said ordinance at the meeting to be held on January 5, 2021.

The Rate Ordinance provides for an increase in rates as set forth in the text of the Rate Ordinance which is included in this Notice. At such public hearing and prior to final adoption of the Rate Ordinance, all interested parties may appear and be heard. The complete text of proposed Rate Ordinance and the Rate Report prepared by the financial advisor are on file and available for examination and copying at the office of the Clerk Treasurer, 331 East Jackson Street; Cicero, IN 46034, Indiana during regular business hours, and will be available at the public hearing.

The public hearing and town council meeting will also be broadcast via Zoom. Due to Covid-19 precautions, the capacity of Red Bridge Community Building is limited to 35 members of the public. The Town Council wishes to encourage interested parties to participate by Zoom if possible.
