2. I & I Project – Mr. Bryant stated that he is still waiting feedback from Duke and 3D has been nonresponsive.
3. Mr. Bryant, President Strong and Mr. Cook are meeting with Peerless Midwest next week to discuss possible well sites.

**Old Business:**

1. Docks – President Strong asked the council if they are in favor of granting Mr. Schiedel’s appeal. By a vote of 4-1, the appeal was denied. Mr. Lutz was the only member to vote in favor of the appeal.
2. Water Shutoff Ordinance – Mr. Culp advised council that he has revised the town’s water ordinance. Council was given a copy to review. President Strong asked Ms. Gary to add it to the next council agenda for a vote.

1. ADA Compliance – ADA Coordinator, CJ Taylor advised the council of the town’s ADA Transition Plan. He had a handout that included the steps to keep the Town of Cicero compliance. He intends to follow up and monitor the transition plan as needed.
