

West Jackson Street Project

- Starting March 31st
- Water lines will be replaced first from State Road 19 to Peal Street.
- South Byron Street will be closed on Thursday April 17th for 1 day for main water installation.
- Unfortunately, we will have a major impact on traffic next week. We will have impact to traffic on West Jackson Street with construction slated for a storm sewer line on the North Side of West Jackson Street in front of Sullivan Hardware & Broncos.

From the east barrels will be placed beginning at 47 W Jackson Street (Gymies) and will end at 120 W Jackson Street (Edward Jones). Barricades will be set up on North & South Byron Street at the intersection with West Jackson Street. No on street parking will be available to these areas until construction is complete. Flaggers will be stationed at both ends of the diversion, as well as 1 flagger in the middle to assist with dump trucks getting in and out of the actual work area.

North Byron Street, from West Jackson to the alleyway will be used as a staging area and no on street parking will be allowed in this area as well. We anticipate this work being completed by the end of Friday, June 6th and traffic being back to normal.

The contractors will be digging and pouring sidewalks, drives, and curbs from Washington Street to Pearl Street on the South side of West Jackson Street. Pour times will approximately around 9:30am. The contractor does anticipate working on Saturday, June 7th.
